Olympic Games

The Modern Olympic Games or Olympics are leading international sporting events featuring summer and winter sports competitions in which thousands of athletes from around the world participate in a variety of competitions.

The Olympic Games are considered world's foremost sports competition with more than 200 nations participating.

Their creation was inspired by ancient Olympic games, which were held in Olympia, Greece from the 8th century BC to the 4th century A.D.

Baron Pierre de Coubertin founded the International Olympic Committee (IOC) in 1894, leading to 1st modern games in Athens in 1896.

⇒ Olympic Flag

Olympic flag was created in 1913 at suggestion of Baron de Coubertin.

It was posted 1st time in the Olympic stadium at Antwerp Olympic 1920.

Olympic flag is made up of white silk and contain five interlocking rings and colours representing five continents of world - Europe, Africa, America, Asia and Australia.

Blue - Europe

Black - Africa

Yellow - Asia

Green - Australia

Red - America

Citius - Faster

Altius - Higher

Fortius - Stronger

⇒ Olympic flame

It is symbol of knowledge, life and happiness.

It also symbolises peace. This flame enlightened in Olympic games of Greece and it is carried by runners to place where Olympic games are going to be organised.

⇒ Arjun Award

Arjun Award is the supreme honour awarded to sport person by govt. of India which is awarded to sports person.

This award is given to such sports persons who achieves extraordinary position during that year.

This award started in 1961. Arjun award includes a statue of Arjun, a diploma and 5 lakh rupee cash.

⇒ Rules for Arjun award

- * This award is given to 1 player of a game but this can be given to female player of same games.

* The govt. of India form a special committee

which inspected the list of player.

- * The govt. of India doesn't receive any list from sports federation.
- * The final decision regarding Arjun Award in hands of govt. of India.
- * Arjun award can not be presented to a player second time.

⇒ Rajeev Gandhi Khel Ratna award

- * This award is presented to one sports person from individual sports but it can be given more than one person in case of team games. A cash amount of rupees 7.5 lakhs. In case the award is given to more than one sports person of team amount shall be 3.75 lakhs for each sport person, the selected sports person for this award also provided a blazer and a tie.

⇒ Dhronacharya award

Govt. of India started Dhronacharya award approaches in 1985.



This award is given to coaches in memory of Biju Bhonacharya. This award is presented to form coaches whose teams or players have good performance at international level.

⇒ Eligibility for Bhonacharya award;

- * The player who has won gold, silver or bronze medal at olympic games.
- * The player who had broken the world record. This record should have been recognized by international sports federation.
- * The player who has won gold medal at Asian games or commonwealth games.
- * The player who has won gold medals in Asian championship or in commonwealth championship.
