(A) Karthick has 45 stamps and his daddy give him 12 more. How many stamps does he have now?

Solve: Total stamps now = $45 + 12 = 57$

(A) There are 28 girls and 41 boys in the first grade.

How many students are there in all in the first grade?

Solve: Total student in the first grade.

$$28 + 41 = 69 \text{ student}$$
