(B) 14 pencil boxes in sets of 7

$$7 \times 3 = 14$$

$$7 \times 2 = 14$$

Repeated sentences = each group has 2 pencil boxes

80 erasers in sets of 8

$$8 \times ? = 80$$

$$8 \times 10 = 80$$

Repeated sentences = each group has 10 erasers.

33 cars in sets of 3

$$3 \times ? = 33$$

$$3 \times 11 = 33$$

Repeated sentence = each group has 11 cars.

Multiplication sentence: each group has 10 sketch pens.

③ 36 markers in 9 groups

$$9 \times ? = 36$$

$$9 \times 4 = 36$$

Multiplication sentences: each group has 4 markers.



Q 16 sharpeners in 8 group

$$8 \times ? = 16$$

$$8 \times 2 = 16$$

Multiplication sentence: each group has 2 sharpeners.
