* Government

- (i) Government is an element of the state.
- This element formulates, expresses and fulfills the will of the state.
- (ii) Government includes all persons or organisations which exercise the power of the state.

* The role it plays in our lives.

- (i) Government makes the laws and protects the life and property of the people.
- (ii) It maintains law and order in which the individual can live peacefully.

* Order functions of government

- (i) It build road, dig canals, construct schools and hospitals.
- (ii) Controlling traffic, eying crimes and fighting wars.
- (iii) It set up industries, run medical services, give pensions to retired people etc.

* Levels of Government

- (i) The government works at different

Levels -

- Local level means town and village.
- State level means state like UP, MP.
- National level like country India, America

* Types of Government

- Democratic government
 - (i) In democracy, people elect their representatives and these representative from the government.
 - (ii) the government has to explain its actions and defend its decision to the people.
- Monarchy
 - (i) In this form of government, the monarch (King or Queen) has the power to make decision and run the government.
 - (ii) King and Queen do not have to explain their actions or defend the decisions they take.
 - (iii) India is a democratic country. It follows Universal Adult franchise.
 - (iv) Universal Adult franchise means every citizen who is 18 or above has right to one vote.

* Suffrage movement

Women's struggle for vote in Europe and U.S.A is called suffrag movement. It gave women right to vote and they began to be seen as being equally capable of making decision. American women got the right to vote in 1920. UK women got the right to vote in 1928.

* Laws and government

The government needs to make rules for everyone in the form of laws because without these laws the government power to make decision is not of much use.

Writing in the journal "young" India in 1931 Gandhiji said, "Every citizen of India should have right to vote."
