- * In ancient times the area to the south of the Ganga was known as Magadha now, lying in the state of Bihar.
- * The places where rice was first grown are to the north of the Vindhya range.
- * Some of the earliest people who lived along the banks of river Narmada for several hundred thousand years. Some of the earliest people who lived here were skilled gatherers - that is people who gathered. Their food. They knew about the vast wealth of plants in the surrounding forests and collected roots, fruits and other forest produce for their food. They also hunted animals.
- * Manuscript = Hand written documents on palm leaves or Birch, trees-bark in language of Sanskrit, Prakrit and Tamil.
- * Inscription - Writing on hard surface, stone or metal or baked clay. Have script - better or right sign.
- * Archaeology = the study of the past based on objects or parts of building that are found in the ground.
