Natural Vegetation and wild life.

Notes :

Forests

Tropical evergreen forests :- These forests are also called tropical rainforests.

These thick forests occur in the regions near the equator and close to the tropics. These regions are hot and receive heavy rainfall throughout the year. As there is no particular dry season, the trees do not shed their leaves altogether. This is the reason they are called evergreen. There are found hardwood trees like rose wood, ebony, mahogany are common here.

Tropical deciduous forests :- Tropical deciduous forest are the monsoon

forests are found in the large part of India, Northern Australia and in central America.

These regions experience seasonal changes. The hardwood trees found in these forests are sal, teak, neem and shisham. The hardwood trees are useful for making furniture, transport and constructional materials. Tigers, lions, elephants, langurs and monkeys are the common animals of these region.

~~Mountain vegetation zones~~. The mountain regions
are situated around 1000m. They are more
moderate than the savanna. It consists of the
savanna type. In south east Asia, much
drier and it looks like desert. They consist
of sand and dry rocks.

~~Mediterranean vegetation~~ - The west and north west
coastal areas of the continents
in Europe have Mediterranean vegetation.
It is mostly found in the areas around
the Mediterranean sea in Spain, France,
Italy, the Iberian Peninsula, Greece, Turkey
and outside the Mediterranean
Argentina.

~~Mountain forest~~ - In the higher latitudes
of northern hemisphere the
temperate coniferous forests are found. These
are the forests in Russia. There are
two forests that are also found in
North America and Greenland in
Canada. They are very useful for
timber, fuel, which is used for
making paper.

Grainlands \Rightarrow Countryside mainly different
countries in different regions.

Pastoral savannas - The savannas on either sides
of the savanna extend into
the jungles. The vegetation grows in the savanna
moderate to less amount of rainfall. They
can grow very tall, like shrubs to 4

metres in height. Savannah grasslands of Africa are of this type. Elephants, zebras, giraffes, deer, leopards are common in tropical grasslands.

Temperate grasslands:- These are found in the mid-latitude zones and in the interior part of the continents. Wild buffaloes, bison, antelopes are common in the temperate region.

Thorny bushes:- These are found in the dry desert like regions. Tropical deserts are located on the western margins of the continents. The vegetation cover is scarce here because of scanty rain and scorching heat. Only mosses, lichens and very short summer. This is called Tundra type of vegetation. This vegetation is found in the polar areas of Europe, Asia and North America.

Tropical grasslands:-

- 1- East Africa - Savanna

Temperate grasslands:-

- 1- Argentina - Pampas

Ans:- The growth of vegetation depends on temperature and moisture. It also depends on factors like slope and thickness of soil.

Q2) Which are the three broad categories of natural vegetation?

Ans:- Natural vegetation is generally classified in to three broad categories as follows:-

(a) Forests:- Which grow where temperature and rainfall are plentiful to support a tree cover. Depending upon these factors, dense and open forests are grown.

(b) Grasslands:- Which grow in the region of moderate rain.

(c) Shrubs:- Thorny shrubs and scrubs grow in the dry region.
