## Lesson - 8

Human Environment  
Interactions the tropical  
and the subtropical region

### Notes:-

- \* Equatorial region :- The tropical region lies very close to the equator; between  $10^{\circ}\text{N}$  and  $10^{\circ}\text{S}$ . So, it is referred to as the equatorial region.
- \* Mouth :- The place where a river flows into another body of water is called the river's mouth.
- \* Climate :- The Amazon basin stretches directly on the equator and is characterized by hot and wet climate throughout the year. Both day and nights are almost equally hot and humid. The skin feels sticky. It rains almost everyday, that too without much warning. The day temperatures are high with very high humidity. At night the temperature goes down but the humidity remains high.
- \* Slash and Burn :- Slash and Burn is a way of cultivating land where farmers clear a piece of land by slashing or cutting down trees and bushes.

These are then burnt, which releases the nutrients into the soil. Now crops are grown in this cleared field for a few years.

\* Life in the Ganga - Brahmaputra basin:- The tributaries

of rivers ganga and Brahmaputra together form the Ganga - Brahmaputra basin in the Indian subcontinent. The basin lies in the sub-tropical region that is situated between  $10^{\circ}\text{N}$  to  $30^{\circ}\text{N}$  latitudes.

The tributaries of the river ganga like the ghaghra, the son, the chambal, the gandak, the kosi and the tributaries of brahmaputra drain it.

- \* The Ganga - Brahmaputra basin has several big towns and cities. The cities of Allahabad, Kanpur, Varanasi, Lucknow, Patna and Kolkata all the population of more than ten lakhs are located along the river Ganga.
